Each of our physicians has specialized orthopaedic surgical training following graduation from medical school, and each is board-certified or eligible through the American Board of Orthopaedic Surgery.

Each of our surgeons has extensive experience and specialized training in specific areas of expertise including joint replacements, complex pelvic reconstructions and spinal surgery. In fact, one of our surgeons was the first in the United States to perform a minimally invasive procedure called vertebral body replacement (VBR) using a STALIF implant for patients experiencing debilitating back pain who cannot find relief from traditional means of treatment.

Our practice employs five certified physician's assistants (PAs). These professionals have advanced education and training. They have fulfilled certification criteria and have passed rigorous examinations. They maintain their professional competence with continued education and are experienced in assisting the physician in all areas of care.

Our orthopaedic surgeons practice throughout the Lehigh Valley and are affiliated with the nationally recognized St. Luke's Hospital & Health Network.

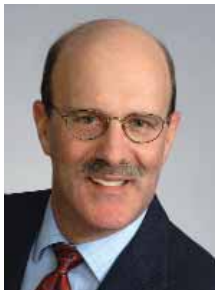
