And in 2003, St. Christopher's became the third pediatric hospital in Pennsylvania to earn the designation of a Regional Level I Pediatric Trauma Center.

A full range of pediatric medical and surgical specialties are made possible through St. Christopher's affiliation with Drexel University College of Medicine. Signature programs include the Stuart J.
