Directions to St. Luke's Hospital – Bethlehem Campus

From Harrisburg/Allentown

Take Route 22 East to Route 378 in Bethlehem. Take Route 378 South three miles to Bethlehem. Go over the Hill-to-Hill Bridge to the light at Delaware Avenue. Turn right on Delaware Avenue. Proceed on Delaware to the first light. Turn right onto St. Luke's Place. The hospital is located at the end of St. Luke's Place.

From Quakertown/Coopersburg via Route 309

Take Route 309 North to Route 378. Take Route 378 North. Route 378 will become Wyandotte Street in Bethlehem. Follow Wyandotte Street to the five-point intersection (at the bottom of the hill). Go straight through the intersection and move into the left lane. Turn left at the first traffic light (4th street). Continue two blocks to the intersection of 4th Street and Delaware Avenue. Proceed on Delaware to the first light. Turn right onto St. Luke's Place. The hospital is located at the end of St. Luke's Place.

From Route 33/Easton via Route 22

Take Route 33 North or South to Route 22 West. Take Route 22 West to Route 378 South. Take Route 378 South three miles to Bethlehem. Go over the Hill-to-Hill Bridge to the light at Delaware Avenue. Turn right on Delaware Avenue. Proceed on Delaware to the first light. Turn right onto St. Luke's Place. The hospital is located at the end of St. Luke's Place.

From the North via Route 309

Follow Route 309 South to Route 22 in Allentown. Take Route 22 East to Route 378. Take Route 378 South three miles to Bethlehem. Go over the Hill-to-

Hill Bridge to the light at Delaware Avenue. Turn right on Delaware Avenue. Proceed on Delaware to the first light. Turn right onto St. Luke's Place. The hospital is located at the end of St. Luke's Place.

Hellertown/Bethlehem exit (Exit 67). At the end of the ramp, turn right on to Route 412 North. Follow Route 412 North to East Third Street. Follow East Third Street for approximately two miles. Cross Route 378 to West Third Street/Delaware Avenue. Follow Delaware Avenue to the first traffic light. Turn right onto St. Luke's Place. The hospital is located at the end of St. Luke's Place.

From Poconos/Scranton/Lehighton via the Northeast Extension of the PA Turnpike

Take the Northeast extension of the turnpike South towards Allentown and the Lehigh Valley exit. Take the Lehigh Valley exit #33. After the tollbooth, take Route 22 East towards Allentown. Take Route 22 East to Route 378. Take Route 378 South three miles to Bethlehem. Go over the Hill-to-Hill Bridge to the light at Delaware Avenue. Turn right on Delaware Avenue. Proceed on Delaware to the first light. Turn right onto St. Luke's Place. The hospital is located at the end of St. Luke's Place.

Philadelphia via the Northeast Extension of the PA Turnpike

Take the Schuylkill Expressway (I-76 West) to I-476. Follow I-476 North (the Northeast Extension of the Pennsylvania turnpike) towards Allentown and the Lehigh Valley exit. Take the Lehigh Valley exit #33. After the tollbooth, take Route 22 East towards Allentown. Take Route 22 East to Route 378. Take Route 378 South three miles to Bethlehem. Go over the Hill-to-Hill Bridge to the light at Delaware Avenue. Turn right on Delaware Avenue. Proceed on Delaware to the first light. Turn right onto St. Luke's Place. The hospital is located at the end of St. Luke's Place.

From other St. Luke's Campuses and affiliated hospitals

From St. Luke's Hospital – Allentown Campus & 19th Street Health Center

Turn right onto Hamilton Street. Follow Hamilton Street to the light at 15th Street. Turn left on 15th Street. Proceed on 15th Street to Route 22. Take Route 22 East to Route 378. Take Route 378 South three miles to Bethlehem. Go over the Hill-to-Hill Bridge to the light at Delaware Avenue. Turn right on Delaware Avenue. Proceed on Delaware to the first light. Turn right onto St. Luke's Place. The hospital is located at the end of St. Luke's Place.

From St. Luke's Miners Memorial Hospital

Exit the hospital parking lot onto Ruddle Street. Travel two blocks and turn left onto 5th Street. Travel one

block to stop sign and turn left onto Route 209 South. Take Route 209 South to Route 309. Follow Route 309 South approximately 35 miles to Route 22 in Allentown. Take Route 22 East to Route 378. Take Route 378 South three miles to Bethlehem. Go over the Hill-to-Hill Bridge to the light at Delaware Avenue. Turn right on Delaware Avenue. Proceed on Delaware to the first light. Turn right onto St. Luke's Place. The hospital is located at the end of St. Luke's Place.

From St. Luke's North

Go to the parking lot exit at Commerce Way and turn left onto Commerce Way. At the stop sign, turn left onto Brodhead Road and go to the stop light at Route 512. Turn left onto Route 512 South and get into the right lane. Go through two stoplights. Before the third light, go up the ramp onto Route 22 West. Continue on Route 22 West to Route 378 South. Take Route 378 South three miles to Bethlehem. Go over the Hill-to-Hill Bridge to the light at Delaware Avenue. Turn right on Delaware Avenue. Proceed on Delaware to the first light. Turn right onto St. Luke's Place. The hospital is located at the end of St. Luke's Place.

From St. Luke's Quakertown Hospital

Take Route 309 North through Coopersburg to Route 378 in Center Valley. Route 378 will become Wyandotte Street in Bethlehem. Follow Wyandotte Street to the five-point intersection (at the bottom of the hill). Go straight through the intersection and get in the left lane. Turn left at the first traffic light (4th street). Continue two blocks to the intersection of 4th Street and Delaware Avenue. Proceed on Delaware to the first light. Turn right onto St. Luke's Place. The hospital is located at the end of St. Luke's Place.
