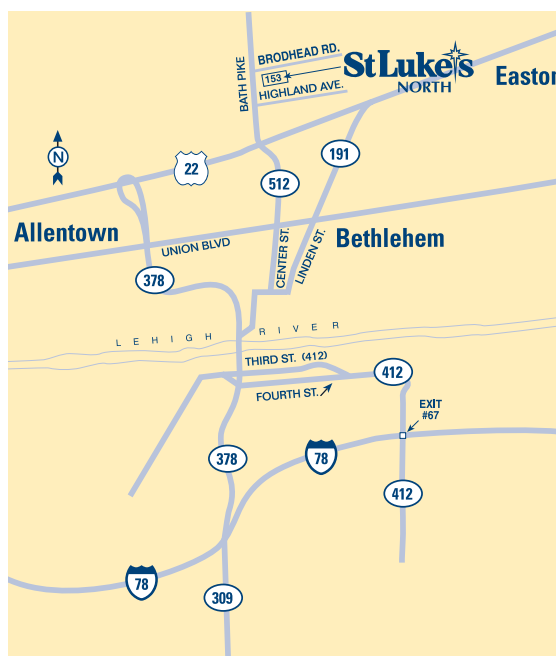

Directions:

From Route 33 via Route 22 – Take Route 33 to Route 22 West and travel approximately five miles to the Route 512 exit. Turn right at the end of the exit ramp and proceed through two stop lights. At the third stop light, turn right onto Brodhead Road. Make the first right into the parking lot. St. Luke's North will be directly in front of you.

From the North/Lehighton/Palmerton areas – Take Route 209 North or South or Route 443 East to Route 248 East. Travel approximately 19 miles to Bath. In Bath, turn right onto Route 512 South. Continue on Route 512 South for 3.5 miles to the light at Brodhead Road in Bethlehem. Turn left onto Brodhead Road. Make the first right into the parking lot. St. Luke's North will be directly in front of you.

From the West/Bethlehem areas – Take Route 378 North to Route 22 East and proceed to the Route 512 North exit. Turn right at the end of the exit ramp and proceed through three stop lights. At the fourth stop light, turn right onto Brodhead Road. Make the first right into the parking lot. St. Luke's North will be directly in front of you.

Directions:

From Harrisburg/Allentown – Take Route 22 East to Route 378 in Bethlehem. Take Route 378 South three miles to Bethlehem. Go over the Hill-to-Hill Bridge to the light at Delaware Avenue. Turn right on Delaware Avenue. Proceed on Delaware to the first light. Turn right onto St. Luke's Place. The hospital is located at the end of St. Luke's Place.

From Quakertown/Coopersburg via Route 309 – Take Route 309 North to Route 378. Take Route 378 North. Route 378 will become Wyandotte Street in Bethlehem. Follow Wyandotte Street to the five-point intersection (at the bottom of the hill). Go straight through the intersection and move into the left lane. Turn left at the first traffic light (4th Street). Continue two blocks to the intersection of 4th Street and Delaware Avenue. Proceed on Delaware to the first light. Turn right onto St. Luke's Place. The hospital is located at the end of St. Luke's Place.

From Route 33/Easton via Route 22 – Take Route 33 North or South to Route 22 West. Take Route 22 West to Route 378 South. Take Route 378 South three miles to Bethlehem. Go over the Hill-to-Hill Bridge to the light at Delaware Avenue. Turn right on Delaware Avenue. Proceed on Delaware to the first light. Turn right onto St. Luke's Place. The hospital is located at the end of St. Luke's Place.

From the North via Route 309 – Follow Route 309 South to Route 22 in Allentown. Take Route 22 East to Route 378. Take Route 378 South three miles to Bethlehem. Go over the Hill-to-Hill Bridge to the light at Delaware Avenue. Turn right on Delaware Avenue. Proceed on Delaware to the first light. Turn right onto St. Luke's Place. The hospital is located at the end of St. Luke's Place.
