### What is a Travel Clinic?

St. Luke's Travel Clinic is staffed by health-care professionals that can provide pre- and post-travel counseling and immunizations. International travel can sometimes require various immunizations to protect your employee's health.

### When should you visit St. Luke's Travel Clinic?

It may take up to 8 weeks to receive a full set of vaccinations for your business trip. Please contact St. Luke's Travel Clinic as soon as you start planning your trip.

### Proof of Immunization is required to enter some countries:

- Yellow fever
- Meningococcal during hajj
- Cholera

### Recommended Vaccinations (Depending on Destination):

- Polio
- Influenza
- Hepatitis B
- Japanese Encephalitis
- Pneumococcal
- Typhoid
- Meningococcal
- Hepatitis A
- Rabies

The St. Luke's Travel Clinic can provide information on destination-specific health concerns. Health tips and travel advice can also be given at the time of your visit to keep you healthy and safe during your travels.
